.01 Purpose.

To establish policy and procedure regarding the treatment team's responsibility at the time of an inmate's recommendation for non-eligibility.

.02 Scope.

Applicable to the Patuxent Treatment Team

.03 Policy.

It is the policy of the Patuxent Institution for the Treatment Team to consider both inmate's welfare and the security of the Institution when making a recommendation for non-eligibility.

.04 Definitions.

A. In this directive, the following terms have the meanings indicated.

B. Terms Defined.

(1) **Non-Eligibility** means an inmate who is no longer eligible to participate in the Patuxent Programs.

.05 Responsibility.

A. In instances where the Treatment Team is making recommendations for non-eligibility of on inmate and the inmate is being informed of this decision, the overall concern regarding the inmate becomes a security matter as well as a treatment issue.

B. The Treatment Team Leader shall be expected to expedite the inmate's appearance before the Board of Review if the inmate is deemed a threat to Institutional security or staff.

C. If the inmate is on close security, the inmate should be removed from close security. Should the security level demotion affect the inmate's job, the job shall be changed.

D. Placement on administrative segregation is an alternative to be considered during the period the inmate is waiting to appear before the Board of Review.

E. Demotion of the inmate to a more secure tier level is something to be considered depending upon the clinical judgment of the Treatment Team.
