- II. Applicable to: All Institutions
- III. Purpose: To provide guidelines for the admission of private physicians, psychiatrists, and/or mental health professionals to examine inmates.
- IV. Procedures:
- A. Examinations of any Division of Correction inmate by private medical, psychiatric, and mental health professionals may be approved by the wardens after consultation with the Attorney General and Commissioner.
- B. Expenses attendant to any examinations outlined in A. above must be borne by the inmate. An inmate enrolled in the Home Detention Unit must follow the home Detention Unit procedure for attending medical, psychological, psychiatrist, etc. appointments.
