

Title: Shift Changes

.01 Purpose.

To establish procedures for the transfer of employees from one shift to another.

.02 Scope.

The Division of Pretrial Detention and Services

.03 Policy.

The transfer of employees from one shift to another shall be based on established criteria, applied in an equitable manner.

.04 Authority/Reference.

None

.05 Definitions.

<u>Seniority</u> - Time in-grade, determined by the Entry on Duty Date as shown on the employee's MS 310.

.06 Responsibility/Procedure.

- A. The final approval for shift changes rests with the appointing authority. The appointing authority or designee may assign or reassign an employee to any shift for the following reasons:
 - To address the staffing level needs of any shift;
 - 2. To use the special skills of an employee that are needed on a particular shift;

- 3. As all, or part, of a disciplinary measure;
- 4. For cross training and career enhancement; or
- 5. For any other reason provided that the shift change does not violate any federal, state, or local statutes.
- B. The following combination of factors shall be considered by the appointing authority or designee when making a determination regarding employee requests for a shift change:
 - 1. The employee's ability in areas of special assignment;
 - 2. Attendance and work records; and
 - 3. Seniority. Seniority shall be the determining factor in cases where factors 1 and 2 appear equal.
- C. Whenever possible, employees shall be given two (2) weeks notice prior to any permanent shift change.
- D. No institutional directive is required if written standard operational procedurals or manuals are in place.
