.01 Purpose

This directive establishes procedures for the admission of newly received Residents.

.02 Scope.

The Division of Pretrial Detention and Services

.03 Policy.

- A. The Division shall enforce written intake policies which ensure a consistent, effective admission process for new residents
- B. Furthermore, compliance shall be maintained with the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Act, ensuring that no juvenile offender under juvenile court jurisdiction is taken into Division custody.

.04 Definitions.

There is no definition for this directive.

.05 Responsibility.

The warden shall be responsible to prepare and enforce written admission procedures, which include provisions for:

- A. Verification of legal commitment, (Note: The Division does not hold juvenile offenders as defined by the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Act);
- B. Search of a resident in accordance with applicable case law;
- C. A system of positive resident identification;

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- D. Collection of personal data; and
- E. Documentation of the opportunity to make initial telephone calls.
