DPDS CHANGE NOTICE EFFECTIVE DATE <u>December 3, 2010</u>

CHANGE NOTICE #1_TO THIS DIRECTIVE

- 1. Replace §.03 B with the following revision:
 - B. If a waived juvenile is remanded to the custody of the Division, the individual shall be housed in a separate unit designated for juveniles which affords no more than incidental sight or sound contact with adult detainees from outside the unit in living, program, dining or other common areas. In addition, the individual shall be staged, transported and escorted separately from adult detainees. Any other sight or sound contact is minimized, brief and in conformance with applicable legal requirements.
- 2. Add §.05 C as follows:
 - D. The Transportation Commander shall be responsible to ensure that all juvenile transports and associated escorts are conducted in compliance with Department Directives which mandate the separation of juvenile and adult detainees.
- 3. Modify all copies of DPDS.100.0003 in your possession by attaching this Change Notice as the first page.
- 4. Inform all appropriate staff of this change.
