

Eligibility Criteria for Participation in Incarcerated Individual Charitable Activity

To be eligible to participate in a charitable activity an incarcerated individual may not have:

- (a) Received any infraction in the 30 days preceding the charitable activity;
- (b) Been on disciplinary segregation during the previous 3 months; or
- (c) Received a guilty finding for a [Category IA Rule Violation](#) during the previous 6 months.

Participation Rules:

- (a) The Finance Office—Incarcerated Individual Accounts can only process a voucher one time.
- (b) A voucher cannot be cancelled after the order is placed.
- (c) No refunds will be given.
- (d) If an incarcerated individual violates any of the eligibility criteria during the time between the order placement for the charitable activity and the delivery of the item, it shall be forfeited.
- (e) The quantity of items available for purchase will be determined by the facility based on the security of the facility and the requirements of the fund raising event.
