


DCD CHANGE NOTICE 11-96 EFFECTIVE DATE March 20, 1996

CHANGE # 1 TO THIS DCD

1. Changes are being made to this directive to clarify when an inmate shall be removed from disciplinary segregation.
2. Delete section VI.U.1. paragraphs a. and d.
3. Section VI.U.1. now reads as follows:
 1. An inmate shall be released from segregation as soon as administratively possible:
 - a. after having completed serving a disciplinary segregation sentence, or
 - b. after the warden or designee authorizes removal.
4. Please ensure that these changes are incorporated into all copies of this DCD.
