



DCD CHANGE NOTICE 19-03 **EFFECTIVE DATE** July 20, 2003

CHANGE # 1 TO THIS DCD

1. Section VI. C. has been changed as follows:

C. Restricted Use of Property:

1. Where applicable, the managing officer may restrict the use of certain property items (i.e., radio/cassette/compact disc player, television, typewriter, and musical instrument) to certain times and locations.
2. Pictures, photographs, drawings, calendars, bulletins, etc., shall not be attached to, nor hung on, the walls, ceilings, windows or any other part of a cell, dormitory, rec-hall or any other area in a State Correctional Facility.
 - a. Inmates may affix the above-mentioned items in a temporary manner to their assigned locker with scotch-type tape, as long as these items do not contain nor depict items of a nude, lewd, pornographic or lascivious nature;
 - b. does not in any manner mark or destroy the locker.
3. Authorized inmate bulletin boards may be used to disseminate information by inmates with the managing officer's/designee's permission.
