- 1. Section VI. C. has been changed as follows:
 - C. Restricted Use of Property:
 - 1. Where applicable, the managing officer may restrict the use of certain property items (i.e., radio/cassette/compact disc player, television, typewriter, and musical instrument) to certain times and locations.
 - 2. Pictures, photographs, drawings, calendars, bulletins, etc., shall not be attached to, nor hung on, the walls, ceilings, windows or any other part of a cell, dormitory, rec-hall or any other area in a State Correctional Facility.
 - a. Inmates may affix the above-mentioned items in a temporary manner to their assigned locker with scotch-type tape, as long as these items do not contain nor depict items of a nude, lewd, pornographic or lascivious nature;
 - b. does not in any manner mark or destroy the locker.
 - 3. Authorized inmate bulletin boards may be used to disseminate information by inmates with the managing officer's/designee's permission.
