**TITLE: Inmate Led Activities** 

I. REFERENCE: COMAR 12.12.17

II. PURPOSE: To establish procedures for inmate contributions to the conduct of worship services, religious education groups, holy day observances and special programs.

III. APPLICABLE TO: Patuxent Institution

## IV. PROCEDURE:

- A. Inmates are authorized to lead congregate religious activities as sanctioned in PID 140-4. Providers of Group Services and Activities.
- B. No inmate, including an activity leader within a religious group, shall have any authority over other inmates in the group.
- C. Staff shall monitor inmate led activities to ensure that inmates adhere to Patuxent Institution Directives and any other rules and regulations governing inmate conduct.
- D. The warden shall retain the authority to remove an inmate activity leader if the leader assumes authority over other inmates or encourages acts of violence or violation of regulations.
- E. Where possible, the warden shall advise external religious authorities of this action.
- F. No religious group may assume a paramilitary structure.
- G. No inmate shall act in the capacity of correctional officer, sentry, sergeantat-arms, or in any capacity suggesting a security function or the enforcement of behavior or rules.
